About EV Advisor service

Note that these services are **not available** for single family homes, duplexes and townhomes with private garages.

Description of MURB / Workplaces Charging Incentives



Eligible Applicants for MURB / Workplaces

MURB

- BC residents
- Building owners
- Building managers
- Building representatives

Workplace

- Business located in BC
- Min. of 5 employees
- Constructed no later than Aug 31, 2019
- Employee parking

Eligible Costs for MURB / Workplaces

Eligible Costs include:

- Site assessment
- Electrical and parking design
- Purchase of the charging station
- Labour and construction costs
- Permits
- Signage

Ineligible Costs for MURBs / Workplaces

Ineligible Costs include, but are not limited to:

- Installation of non-EV infrastructure
- Administration costs
- Painting of parking area
- Charging station subscription fees
- Taxes
- Charging infrastructure already required under regulation, building codes, or other programs

EV Charging Equipment Requirements

EV Charging Equipment Requirements:

- Be purchased in B.C
- cUL, cETL, cQPS, CSA certification
- Level 2 with SAE J1772 plug head
- Be purchased, not leased
- Be a permanent installation
- Be networked
- Be installed by a **licensed electrical contractor**

Steps in Application Process for MURB / Workplaces

Application Process

1. Submit your application for review and pre-approval
 - I. Quote of work
 - II. Proof of approval
 - III. License or status
 - IV. Contractor consultation form
2. Purchase and install charging stations
3. Submit final documentation

Required documents for MURB Applications

Required documents for MURB applications:

- [Proof of approval to install the charging station form](#)
- Proof of BC business license, non-profit status, and or strata status in BC
- Proof that the applicant has authority to install charging stations

- Quote for the work to be completed

Required documents for Workplace Applications

Required documents for Workplace applications:

- Proof of BC business license, non-profit status, and or strata status in BC
- [Proof of approval to install the charging station](#)
- Quote of work to be completed
